Following an unfortunate accident involving a member of the public on Sunday 30th November a complaint was received from the Manager at Haden Hill Leisure Centre that there were a number of children belonging to members of the Club being left to entertain themselves round the building.

A REMINDER

You, as the parent or the adult in charge of swimmers brought to the pool, are responsible for the safety and well being of those swimmers and have a duty to ensure that they respect the well being of other Haden Hill families and Leisure Centre users.

Children should not be allowed to wander and certainly not create ball games and other activities that encourage physical contact or challenge.

This is also a good time to remind you that the only time our staff are responsible for the swimmers is when they are on the poolside. It is a parental duty to encourage behaviour which respects the aims of the Club and the well being of families in and around the Centre.

And a final reminder. If you are bringing swimmers to the pool and not staying yourself it is a family responsibility to check there are Haden Hill staff in place to take the session. PLEASE DO NOT DROP swimmers and make assumptions. Check before you leave in the interests of safety and well being especially in inclement weather.
