We are holding Time Trials In the 25m Pool. **Held under asa Law**

(This is when a swimmer swims his/her fastest against the clock to gain a time.
This time is then entered into our Competitive file records for future reference)

Time Trials will take place on

Sunday 18th & Sunday 25th July ---- Start time 5pm

Swims Over 25m & 50m on all four strokes

(Note: We will run two strokes on each of the days)

Ages for swimmers 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 years of age by Sep 12th 2010

We expect all swimmers from the following Groups to attend.

1. **Swimmers in teaching** who wish to become a competitive swimmer and who are of the required age group and standard.
(If you are not sure your child is of the required standard please ask your child's Teacher)

2. **Pre - Skill Development** (Thursday evening with Carol & Martyn)

3. **Skill Development Swimmers** (3 nights with Neil and Richard)

**Swimmers are required to keep warm on the poolside whilst waiting for their swim.
Could all swimmers bring an extra towel, flip flops t-shirt and bottoms, it is advisable to bring a drink of water or squash in sport / plastic bottle, and your best pair of goggles.**
